

> Situated at the confluence of the Aisne and Oise rivers, Compiègne is in the heart of Compiègne area. A royal and imperial city, the scene of major events in French history, it remains a nice place to live in, a city which pays attention to keeping alive the memory of its great past. Its Imperial Palace, its City Hall, its churches and its museums attest a onethousand year old life that visitors can go all over as they like.




Transformed and enlarged under Louis XVI, then developed by Napoleon I after the revolution, the Palais de Compiègne experienced its hour of glory thanks to Napoleon III.

On 11 November 1918, the armistice was signed putting bringing the First World War to an end. The museum shows a carriage identical to the one used on that day and contains a large number of historic souvenirs of the two World Wars.



Built in the 15th century by Louis d'Orléans, dismantled in the 17th century and then rebuild by order of Napoleon III, this is a wonderful interpretation by Violletle-Duc. It offers an unforgettable visit: a full fortress defence system and imperial apartments.
